











BRONTE VILLAGE.

Welcome to Bronte Village! We are a thriving community on Lake Ontario that is vibrant, unique and growing.

A designated tourism location with a waterfront and marina that is considered one of the best in the GTA, Bronte is one of Ontario's oldest communities and has retained its "small-town-tight-knit-community-feel". Our commercial district, which is a mix of locally owned & independent shops, chain stores, destination retailers and restaurants, completes the overall character and charm of the neighbourhood.

Bronte is home to over 13,600 residents, 175 businesses and continues to grow, with 2,500 new residents expected to join the community within the next three years.

It is a 15-minute drive from anywhere in Oakville and easily accessible by transit. Bronte is a designated bike-friendly district and an appealing year-round environment for residents, businesses and visitors.



AN EVOLVING & CHANGING DEMOGRAPHIC.

Considered one of Oakville's most sought after neighbourhoods - an intersection of city life and suburban waterfront living - Bronte is transforming itself into an exciting, complete community designed for the future.


When people visit Bronte, they take-in green space, sports & recreation, arts & culture, robust retail offerings and heritage & history. It is a place people visit to gather and belong, define common purpose, and bridge across differences.

Projected growth within the next three years is 2,500 new residents, with development adding 1,224 residential units to our community. This resurgence in development is attracting boomers, young families and professionals that are active, financially comfortable, savvy residents living the good life.

At present, the neighbourhood is predominantly home to single-family homeowners (51%) and apartment dwellers (25%) with an average household income of \$127,372. Twenty-one percent of the population identifies as a visible minority. The median age is 48 and 18 percent of local residents are seniors.

The make-up of visitors is split evenly between hyper-locals (15-minute walk/5-minute drive) and people coming from the neighbouring municipalities of Burlington, Milton, Mississauga, Toronto and beyond.
